Stair measurements are critical for a successful installation. We require that you provide the measure of the stairs off the actual steps. We need two critical hard measures.

1) The slope of the steps needs to be in degrees from horizontal. This is very simple to measure. Just go to Home Depot, Lowes, Harbor Freight and pick up a angle finder similar to one of these for under \$10.









Lay a level or piece of wood on the stairs, sit the angle finder on the wood and just read off the slope. Check a couple spots ie top middle bottom. Most stairs run somewhere around 33 - 36 degrees.

2) We need a dimension from the nose of the bottom step to the nose of the landing.
